#### Cooperation in Education and Research

In order to facilitate student exchanges between SRG Pharma and Dr.K.V. Subba Reddy Institute of Pharmacy, the following section provides general procedural information under which the exchange of students between the two institutions will take place. Specific procedures, requirements and duties of the parties in connection with student exchanges shall be set forth in a separate

written program agreement to be executed by the parties.

Cooperation and exchanges may take place with undergraduate, graduate, students. Each exchange maybe for the duration of one academic year, one academic semester, or one intensive course, normallythree or four weeks in length, scheduled either between academic terms or during the summer.

International students studying in the United States will be required to purchase healthinsurance to meet certain standards such as medical evacuation and repatriation of remains.]





1. Developing research projects jointly and avail funding:


